

Subject: Invitation to share your priorities about nursing work conditions in a Monash University study

What is this study about?

Researchers from Monash University are conducting a research study to better understand what matters to nurses and midwives when choosing hospital nursing jobs. The results will help with the design of jobs that are suited to nurses and midwives and provide the supports that are most important to them.

Who do we want to participate?

Full-time/part-time Registered Nurses, Enrolled Nurses, and Midwives who are currently working in Victorian metropolitan public hospitals are invited to take part in an anonymous online survey. The survey asks participants to consider a series of hypothetical job scenarios and select the jobs they prefer. Completing the survey will take approximately 15-20 minutes. Participants may also choose to enter a prize draw for a chance to win one of two AUD\$200 vouchers.

Is the survey anonymous?

Participation in this study is entirely voluntary. All responses are anonymous, and no identifying information will be collected as part of the survey. You may choose not to participate or withdraw at any time before submitting the survey.
